The Mitchell Elementary School is offering an After-School Enrichment Program which will begin Tues., Oct. 16th and run until Dec. 13th. The cost of each class is listed separately. Classes will run one day per week. Log on to gmes.bridge-rayn.org and click on the **For Students and Parents Menu** and click on **After School Enrichment Program** to learn more about the activities that are being offered and to make payment. Fill out the registration slip, attach the proof of payment and send it in within one day of paying the online registration fee, as this will complete your registration process. **Your child WILL NOT be registered without proof of payment AND registration form (see back for reg. form).** Your child will receive an enrollment notice with class details. **Registration ends Oct 10th or when classes are filled.** Space is limited and sign up is first come, first served basis. One registration form per student. ***If classes are cancelled due to inclement weather, makeups will be scheduled if the instructor is available.**
